Built entirely in the Kimber Custom Shop,™ it has a Carry Melt™ treatment for rounded and blended edges that will not snag on clothing or holsters, along with a premium KimPro II™ finish that is both self-lubricating and extremely resistant to the elements. The high cut under the trigger guard and thin rosewood grips fit smaller hands, increasing accuracy and control. A crisp single-stage match grade trigger breaks at 4–5 pounds without creep or overtravel, far superior to that of modern pistols. Standard Kimber features include lowered and flared ejection port and polished breech face for dependable feeding, extraction and ejection. The chamber and trigger are machined to exacting match grade dimensions for unequal accuracy. The Ultra Aegis II also has a bobbed thumb safety and rounded magazine release button.



Aegis pistols have thin rosewood grips, 30 lines-per-inch front strap checkering and a high cut under the trigger guard. Even small hands can get a proper grip, and a 9mm is easier to control under recoil.



Wide slide serrations, bobbed thumb safety and smooth magazine release button are some of the Custom Shop features that make Aegis pistols ideal for true concealed and backup carry.



Tactical Wedge three dot (green) night sights transition perfectly into the flat top slide. Ramped match grade barrels, chambers and trigger groups are standard.
